2010-2011 Before and After-School Care Programs

Before/After-School Programs

After-School Programs are offered at the following schools: Roosevelt, Merrill, Washington, Smith, Jefferson, Lakeside and Jacob Shapiro. These programs run from school dismissal until 6:00pm Monday through Friday.

The children will have the opportunity to work on homework, do an art activity, participate in a gym activity, and have time for free play and/or outside time. Snack will be served daily at 3:15pm. Before-school care is offered at Lakeside only, from 6:30 a.m.-8:30 a.m. Activities and homework help are offered & breakfast is served at 8:00a.m.

Weekly fees for the After-School Program are \$49.00 for one child, \$35.00 for each additional child in the family. Before-school care weekly rates are \$37.00 for the first child, \$24.00 for each additional child. The weekly rate is charged regardless of how often your child attends or how long he or she is there each day.

Registration Information

Registration is taken on a first-come, first-serve basis, so sign up early! No registrations will be taken before Monday, May 3rd, 2010. Even those children who are currently enrolled must re-enroll for next year's program. You must have the following upon registration: 1) child's immunization history, two emergency contacts (other than mom and dad) with addresses and phone numbers at both home and work. Form must be *completely* filled out to accept registration. 2) Registration and first weeks Fee are also due at this time: \$25.00 for the first child, \$15.00 for the second child, and \$10.00 for the third child. The registration fee must only be paid once if your child is attending both programs. 3) Health history form.
